Important information

- 1) Bring your own rod. This is pier fishing, but heavy saltwater gear is not necessary. A sturdy freshwater rod and reel will suffice.
- 2) Tackle should include hooks roughly the size of a dime, 1-2 oz. round or oval lead sinkers (not pyramid shaped), and at least 6# test line.
- 3) Bait and instruction will be provided by Boy Scouts and Marin Rod and Gun Club.
- 4) If you plan on working on the Belt Loop or Merit Badge, be familiar with the requirements before the event and bring a blue card.
- 5) Bring plenty of water, a hat, a jacket and sun screen! BE PREPARED
- 6) NO LICENSE REQUIRED. This is California's free fishing day!
- 7) Pre-registration only by deadline for registration is Wednesday, June 9th.
- 8) Open to all Cubs, Scouts, and their families and friends!
